It is hoped that the content of this syllabus will give pupils a sense of being on a quest of discovery. A key feature of the syllabus is the large number of questions included in each unit; which must be clearly displayed in class. The purpose of these questions is to give pupils the opportunity to investigate, reflect, evaluate and make meaning. In doing so they will discover more about themselves, their relationships with others, their relationship with the world around them and their relationship with God.

We regard the teaching of Religious Education as both a huge responsibility and a privilege that must be recognised by those who teach it.

Religious Education at Christ Church is taught either once per week or as a block e.g. for a 6 week half term, 6 RE lessons need to be evidenced in either the children's RE or scrapbooks.
