Draw and label them.

Design and make your own boat.

What kind of boat will it be?

What features do you need to include? What materials will you use?

Where would you like to sail to in a pirate ship?

Create an imaginary island that you would visit and decide where you would hide your treasure. Be careful where you leave your map!
