Jesus said to him, "Salvation has come to this house today, for this man, also, is a descendant of Abraham. The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

Creative Prayer 2 \approx Prayer walk

Wondering

- I wonder what you think about this story
- I wonder what you would do to be able to see Jesus
- I wonder what you might like to serve Jesus if he came for tea



Go for a walk together. You might not be able to see a Sycamore tree like the one Zacchaeus climbed but what can you see in God's wonderful creation? Other trees? Plants? Flowers? Are there things growing in between cracks on the pavement or on the side of the road? Can you hear birds singing? Can you see any changes since the last time you looked? Take time to notice. Nature is always changing. If you can find a suitable spot, just stop for a while. Spend some time talking about what you are grateful for in nature and thanking God for those things.

Creative Prayer 2≈ Prayer leaves



Even though Zacchaeus wasn't very nice to other people, Jesus treated him well and even went to stay at his house. After that, everything changed for Zacchaeus. It can be hard to treat other people the way we would like to be treated if they haven't been very nice to us. Think of someone you find it difficult to get along with or who has hurt your feelings. Find a leaf or make a leaf shape from some scrap paper and write their initials on it. Talk to God about how you feel and ask him to be with that person and to help you to forgive them. Put it somewhere to remind you to pray for them every day this week. Maybe there is someone you haven't been very kind to spend some time talking to God about that and ask him to help you to change how you treat them.
